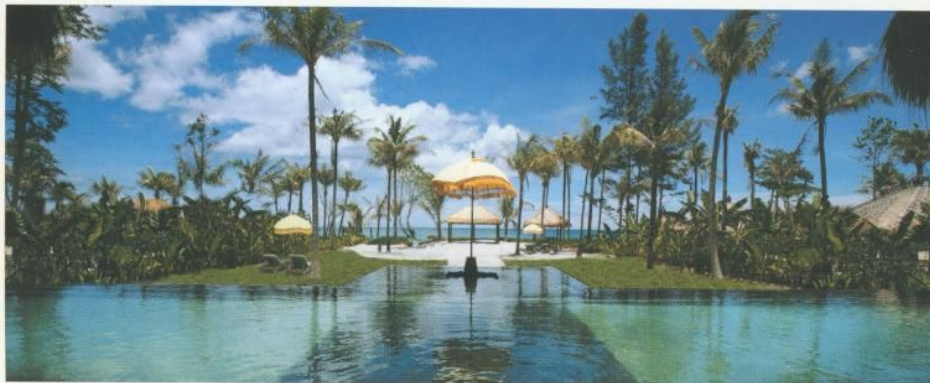


## BORNEO IDYLL
