

Land & Sea Cave Exploring

Explore the majestic elephant cave on a traditional bamboo raft and discover hidden lagoons by sea cave canoe.



In neighboring Phang Nga Province, just over Sarasin bridge, awaits a magical area of rigorously unspoiled nature, secret temples, a floating gypsy village and stunning sea caves ready to be explored.

Join us for an unforgettable day trip visiting the famous reclining Buddha in a cave estimated to be over 160 years old. Next stop will be the majestic Elephant Cave with its endless waterways & tunnels and impressive stalactite formations thousands of years old. We leave Phang Nga bay by traditional long tail boat and stop briefly to have lunch on the iconic floating gypsy village drifting deep in the Phang Nga river estuary. After lunch we explore the stunning sea caves & hidden lagoons and make a brief stop at the iconic James Bond Island before returning to the Heaven of all Heavens.
