

Paresa's Heritage Night Walk

Re-discover Phuket old town's rich cultural heritage by night



This exclusive Heritage Night Walk is aimed at re-discovering the charm and authenticity of "old" Phuket at night, learning from the locals what island life was like 60 years ago by visiting local shrines, old shops, pay respect to the spirits at the local amulet market where protection charms can be "rented".

Walk along the historic Chinese shop houses in the oldest streets of Phuket Town and soak up the rich cultural history when Phuket old town comes alive with traders, shoppers & party goers

We leave at 16.30pm to catch the best time at the market. Eat street food like a local and taste delicious Muslim & Chinese influenced food brought here by the Hokkien immigrants in the 19th century.

Some sections of Phuket's old town dates right back from 1880 and some printing shops are still in operation today. The Indian sarong sellers & the hardware stores all date from the 1920's. There is a nostalgic feeling about town that you should experience before modern times swept it all away.

This sleepy village-like community has been preserved in time and the best way to experience it is at night in the cool evening breeze with centuries old Chinese shop house as a backdrop. The charm and true authenticity of this magical old town is hard to find anywhere else in Thailand.
